Academic excellence at Arlington Memorial High School is recognized in a variety of ways:

- The National Honor Society inducts those students who qualify for membership
- Principal’s Honors: the student with the highest GPA, with no grade below 80.
- High Honors: Students who have earned a GPA above 90 with no grade below an 80.
- Honors: Students who have earned a GPA of 80 or above with no grade below an 80.

To qualify for Principal’s Honors, High Honors and Honors, a student must be taking 5 credits, which include a minimum of 3 core courses (English, Science, Math, Social Studies, World Languages). Other courses may be considered to fulfil the core class requirement on a case-by case basis.
